Suzanne Miyamoto is the CEO of the American Academy of Nursing (Academy). The Academy's mission is to serve the public and the nursing profession by advancing health policy, practice, and science through organizational excellence and effective nursing leadership. With nearly two decades of policy, advocacy, and leadership experience, Dr. Miyamoto directs the internal operations and infrastructure to help the organization achieve its mission, vision, and strategic plan.

Dr. Miyamoto is highly regarded for her expertise in health care and education policy as well as her leadership and successful development of advocacy-based coalitions. From 2008-2018, she led the Nursing Community Coalition which was focused on inserting the voice of the profession in health policy discussions.

Currently, Dr. Miyamoto is an adjunct assistant professor at Georgetown University, School of Nursing and Health Studies. She has held prior academic positions at the Schools of Nursing at the University of Michigan, University of New Mexico, University of Maryland, George Washington University, Marymount University, and Johns Hopkins University.

Dr. Miyamoto is a member of the Editorial Board for the journal *Policy, Politics & Nursing Practice*, The Joint Commission's Nursing Advisory Council, the National Minority Quality Forum's Advisory Board, and a public member of the Organization of Associate Degree Nursing's Board of Directors. She is the Host and Executive Producer of *Inside the Bubble- A Health Policy Podcast*.

Previously, she held roles at the state and federal level with the National Institutes of Health, the State Commission on Patient Safety for the Michigan Health and Safety Coalition, and former United States Congressman Joseph Knollenberg. Dr. Miyamoto's areas of research, publications, and presentations focus on health policy, coalition building, and political advocacy.

Dr. Miyamoto received her Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Bachelor of Arts in Psychology, Master of Science in Nursing, and Doctorate of Philosophy in Nursing from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. She is a member of Sigma Theta Tau International, Women in Government Relations, Academy Health, the American Organization of Nurse Executives, and the American Nurses Association. Dr. Miyamoto is a Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing, an Honorary Friend of the National Institute of Nursing Research, and a 2014 Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Executive Nurse Fellow.
